Take steps to protect yourself

- **Do NOT socialize** (avoid all types of social gatherings)
- **Avoid** any unnecessary traveling or shopping (do online shopping)
- Wash your hands frequently often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds especially
 after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing
- **Avoid** touching your eyes, nose, and mouth
- **Avoid** close contact with people who are sick. This is especially important for people who are at higher risk of getting very sick.

Take steps to protect your neighbors

- Stay home if you are feeling sick except to get medical care.
- Cover coughs and sneezes
- Throw used tissues in the trash.
- Regularly wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Clean AND disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily.
